

Science & Wisdom LIVE is a Public Engagement project that brings scientists in conversation with contemplative practitioners from all religions and backgrounds, to stimulate an exchange of ideas and the sharing of practical tools used in faith-based forms of contemplation, meditation and mindfulness. Science & Wisdom LIVE curates public events such as talks, dialogues, and interviews; produces a podcast series; and distributes all its material in video format on a dedicated YouTube channel.

Science & Wisdom LIVE aims to bridge the gap between academic and religious communities through the organisation of local and international dialogues and symposia. These events will focus on “big questions” at the intersection of science and contemplative wisdom, such as:

- How can we understand the connection between consciousness and physical and biological processes in our brains?
- How can contemplative traditions help us face the climate crisis and foster a healthier connection with our environment?
- What is the role of education in tackling global challenges and what form should it take to contribute to a more sustainable future?

Contributors will be chosen among accomplished researchers with a strong record of academic research and publications, and among experienced contemplative practitioners of different religious backgrounds (Christianity, Buddhism, Judaism, Islam/Sufism, Hinduism) or spiritual lineages (indigenous or otherwise).

LOOKING BACK: 2021

While scientific research is at an all-time high and many people engage in spiritual practices, there is still a significant lack of exchange between religion and science, mainly due to the prevalence of a materialistic worldview among scientific institutions. Yet breakthroughs in contemplative science, neuroscience and quantum physics show that science and contemplative wisdom can strengthen and benefit each other.

Science & Wisdom LIVE endeavours to bridge this gap by promoting exchanges between scientists and contemplative practitioners. Through the organisation of events, talks, and dialogues, we link scientific research directly to the insights and tools (such as meditation) of contemplative traditions (i.e. the world religions and indigenous spiritual traditions) and distribute this knowledge to the larger public in a non-sensationalistic, objective way.

We offer a unique glocal approach, combining local events with global outreach and cutting-edge e-learning programmes. We disseminate evidence-based knowledge through a large Public Engagement project and e-learning courses. This format has the potential to be adapted both locally and globally by different organisations (much like the TEDx format), promoting the creation of a collaborative.


Statistics 2021 and Projections for 2022

In only one year time, Science & Wisdom LIVE has grown from scratch into a full-blown organisation with its own public, followers, and supporters. This is largely due to the very active outreach programme of this past year but has also benefitted greatly from partnerships and mutual PR agreements with other organisations.

We are very optimistic about the prospects of growth for Science & Wisdom LIVE. Based on this first year of existence, we can safely predict that the growth of Science & Wisdom LIVE will continue steadily during the coming year. Here are some statistic projections to underwrite this growth.

Newsletter and YT subscriptions

We have exceeded our earlier expectations based on the first 6 months of the project for YouTube subscriptions (in green), although the Newsletter subscriptions are slightly below the projections (in orange). The projections the next year, assuming linear growth based on the last 12 months, indicate that our audience is growing and will keep on growing in 2022.



Statistics 2021 and Projections for 2022


Newsletter and YT subscriptions

Our subscriptions on social media have been growing steadily throughout 2021.






Financial Health

We are happy to announce that Science & Wisdom LIVE will close its first year of activity with a positive net income:

We expect our total running costs for 2022 to be around £30,000, broken down as follows.






